

Academic Communication and Presentation Skills in English, 3 ECTS

(Maximum number of students: 12)

Contents

The course aims to cultivate effective academic presentation skills and to develop students' confidence and presentation style. Students will practice communicating their research ideas in English to an academic audience. This will be achieved through exploring what makes a good presentation while considering the needs of an international audience, practicing giving presentations, and giving and receiving feedback on presentations.

Learning objectives

After successfully completing the course, the doctoral candidate will

- understand the content and execution of effective presentations
- have established a foundation from which to give effective presentations and develop their individual presentation style
- be practiced at giving constructive feedback on presentations.

Methods

This participation-based course takes a dialogic approach; it involves exercises, discussions, giving presentations and actively being involved in the feedback process.
